QUALIFICATIONS: Valid PA Certificate as a Teacher of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing
 Responsibilities include providing direct instruction and/or consultative services to students; evaluating and assessing students' academic and communication needs; working in conjunction with the audiologist, train students and teachers on individual and/ or classroom amplification systems; collaborating and consulting with team members to develop Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) that will meet student's needs; adapting or modifying learning objectives as they are defined by the Common Core State Standards, and teaching to achieve said outcomes; training students and staff members in the use of assistive technology devices related to hearing impairments; consult with the audiologists on student's hearing loss and use of appropriate amplification; effectively communicate with both deaf and hard of hearing students, using sign language when appropriate; collect data to document student progress toward IEP goals; maintain weekly instruction plans and consultation logs.
